## **Depth of burns**


- Superficial burn
  - · Only the outermost layer of skin is affected
  - · Redness, swelling and tenderness
  - 5% or more must be sent to hospital
- Partial thickness burn
  - · Rawness and blisters
  - · 1% or more must be sent to hospital
  - 9% will cause shock



- Full thickness burn
  - · The two layers of the skin, the epidermis and dermis, are burnt
  - Requires hospital treatment







- **Gently remove any** jewellery or wrist watches
- Cover the area with a sterile dressing





- **DO NOT** apply adhesive dressings
- **DO NOT** apply lotions, ointments or fats
- DO NOT attempt to remove anything sticking to the burn
